ASH Ashman, Linda. *M Is for Mischief: An A to Z of Naughty Children*. 2008.  
A rhyme for each letter of the alphabet describes the misbehavior of a child, from Angry Abby to Zany Zelda.
- E  
BEL Bellefontaine, Kim. *ABC of America*. 2004.  
From apple pie to San Diego Zoo, explore the alphabet on a guided tour of American places, faces, and fun.
- E  
BLA Blackstone, Stella. *Alligator Alphabet*. 2005.  
Animals represent each letter of the alphabet, from alligators to zebras.

BRU Bruel, Nick. *Bad Kitty*. 2005.  
When a kitty discovers there is no cat food in the house, she decides to become very, very bad and takes us on a mad and manic joyride through the alphabet.

CRO Cronin, Doreen. *Click, Clack, Quackity-Quack*. 2005.  
An assortment of animals gather for a picnic and an alphabetical adventure.

DOY Doyle, Charlotte. *The Bouncing, Dancing, Galloping ABC*. 2006.  
Presents an ABC of action words starring energetic children who climb, hop, and zoom their way through the alphabet.

ELY Elya, Susan Middleton. *F Is for Fiesta*. 2006.  
A rhyming book that outlines the preparations for and celebration of a young boy's birthday, with Spanish words for each letter of the Spanish alphabet, translated in a glossary.

FAR Farmer, Bonnie. *ABC: Letters in the Library*. 2004.  
Introduces young readers to the alphabet through an exploration of things found at the library.

FLE Fleming, Denise. *Alphabet under Construction*. 2002.  
Mouse is hard at work constructing each letter of the alphabet. He dyes the D and erases the E, working his way right through to Z.

HOR Horowitz, Dave. *Twenty-Six Princesses*. 2008.  
Twenty-six princesses, one for each letter of the alphabet, go to a party at the prince's castle.

HOS Hosta, Dar. *I Love the Alphabet*. 2004.  
Animals introduce the letters of the alphabet with colorful pictures and rhyming text.

LEA MacDonald, Suse. *Edward Lear's A Was Once an Apple Pie*. 2005.  
A collection of twenty-six nonsense rhymes, one for each letter of the alphabet. Adapted from the poem by Edward Lear.

LON London, Jonathan. *Do Your ABC's, Little Brown Bear*. 2005.  
As they spend a day playing together near their home, Little Brown Bear goes through his ABCs for Papa Brown Bear.

MCL McLeod, Bob. *SuperHero ABC*. 2006.  
Humorous superheroes such as Goo Girl and The Volcano represent the letters of the alphabet from A to Z.

MOS Most, Bernard. *ABC T-Rex*. 2004, c2000.  
T-Rex loves the alphabet so much that he wants to eat it up. So he takes a bite or two, and he finds that C is Chewy, D is delicious, and K tastes great with ketchup.

NIK Nikola-Lisa, W. *My Teacher Can Teach ... Anyone!* 2004.  
An alphabet story in verse about a Latino boy and his remarkable teacher who can teach an astronaut how to float in space and instruct a ballet dancer how to land with grace.

Fancy Nancy provides one or more of her favorite fancy words for each letter of the alphabet.

When a child tries to teach the alphabet to ten insatiable monsters, things quickly get out of hand and chaos abounds until the teacher returns with just the right threat to chase them all away.
