J 387.28 FLO	Floca, Brian. <i>Lightship</i> . 2007. Lightships once served where lighthouses could not be built. They helped to guide sailors through the fog.
J 398.2 MAC	MacDonald, Margaret Read. <i>Go To Sleep, Gecko!: A Balinese Folktale</i> . 2006. Retells the folktale of the gecko who complains to the village chief that the fireflies keep him awake at night but then learns that in nature all things are connected.
J 513.211 CLE	Clements, Andrew. <i>A Million Dots</i> . 2006. Teaches forty-six amazing facts about numbers, such as how many shoeboxes it takes to make a stack to Mount Everest.
J 529 HUT	Hutchins, H.J. <i>A Second Is a Hiccup: A Child's Book of Time</i> . 2007. Simple rhyming text explains seconds, minutes, weeks, months, and years.
J 571.8 SEE	Seeger, Laura Vaccaro. <i>First the Egg</i> . 2007. Shows how animals and objects change, including tadpoles to frogs and seeds to flowers.
J 578.7789097 ARN	Arnosky, Jim. <i>Parrotfish and Sunken Ships: Exploring a Tropical Reef</i> . 2007. Illustrations and text identify the marine life and explore the tropical reefs found in the Florida Keys.
J 597.89 BIS	Bishop, Nic. <i>Nic Bishop Frogs</i> . 2008. Photographs show all different kinds of frogs, big ones, tiny ones, frogs with beautifully colored skin, and one frog you can see inside of.
J 597.956 COW	Cowley, Joy. <i>Chameleon Chameleon</i> . 2005. Up-close photographs and text capture the many moods and colors of chameleons.
J 811 HER	<i>Here's a Little Poem: A Very First Book of Poetry</i> . Collected by Jane Yolen and Andrew Fusek Peters. 2007. Poems written by a wide range of talented writers highlight the moments of a toddler's world from dawn to dusk.
J 921 COU	Berne, Jennifer. <i>Manfish: A Story of Jacques Cousteau</i> . 2008. In this biography, poetic text and paintings combine to create a portrait of oceanographer Jacques Cousteau.
J 921 SOC	Wise, Bill. <i>Louis Sockalexis: Native American Baseball Pioneer</i> . 2007. A biography of Penobscot Indian Louis Sockalexis, the first Native American to play in the Major Leagues.

J 133.9013 BRO	Browne, Sylvia, and Chris Dufresne. <i>Animals on the Other Side</i> . 2005. Explanation and consideration of what animals experience in the afterlife and the concept of good and bad as they apply to animals' nature.
J 304.873 BIA	Bial, Raymond. <i>Ellis Island: Coming to the Land of Liberty</i> . 2009. Tells the complete history of the national landmark, highlighting its most notable purpose as an immigration service station that welcomed nearly twelve million people to the U.S. from 1921 to 1954.
J 306.85 KUK	Kuklin, Susan. <i>Families</i> . 2006. Children from diverse families share thoughts about their families and photographs.
J 420.9 DUB	Dubosarsky, Ursula. <i>The Word Snoop</i> . 2009. A tour of the English language from the beginning of the alphabet in 4000 BC to modern text messaging and emoticons.
J 509 FRA	Fradin, Dennis B. <i>With a Little Luck: Surprising Stories of Amazing Discoveries</i> . 2006. Discusses eleven scientific discoveries made as a result of chance events and unexpected laboratory results.
J 629.454 THI	Thimmesh, Catherine. <i>Team Moon: How 400,000 People Landed Apollo 11 on the Moon</i> . 2006. The story of the many people in various professions who worked behind-the-scenes to get Apollo 11 to the moon and safely back to Earth.

J 910.922 KIR	Kirkpatrick, Katherine. <i>Snow Baby: The Arctic Childhood of Admiral Robert E. Peary's Daring Daughter</i> . 2007. Profiles the life of the woman who, as a child, often accompanied her famous explorer father, Robert Peary, on many of his expeditions.

J 920 LIN	Fleming, Candace. <i>The Lincolns: A Scrapbook Look at Abraham and Mary.</i> 2008. Though Abraham and Mary Todd Lincoln's backgrounds differed considerably, both were intellectuals who shared interests in literature and politics, as well as a great love for each other.
J 921 EAR	Tanaka, Shelley. <i>Amelia Earhart: The Legend of the Lost Aviator.</i> 2008. Describes the life of aviator Amelia Earhart from age eleven, when someone points out a plane to her, to the day she disappears.
J 921 SIS	Sis, Peter. <i>The Wall: Growing Up Behind the Iron Curtain.</i> 2007. Annotated illustrations, maps, and dreamscapes explore how the artist-author's life was shaped while growing up in Czechoslovakia during the Cold War.
J 940.5315 RUS	Russo, Marisabina. <i>Always Remember Me: How One Family Survived World War II.</i> 2005. When she visits her Oma, Rachel looks through family albums and learns the awful truth about the Nazis' rise to power and the hardships her family was forced to endure during the Holocaust.
J 973.21 LAN	Lange, Karen E. <i>1607: A New Look at Jamestown.</i> 2007. The latest archaeological evidence offers us the clearest glimpse of one of the most fascinating chapters in American history.
