

- J/YA LEVINE Levine, Gail. [The Two Princesses of Bamarre](#). 2001
With her adventurous sister suffering from the Grey death, meek and timid Princess Addie sets out to find a cure and encounters monsters and other dangers along the way
- J SAGE Sage, Angie. [Magyk](#). 2005
After learning that she is the Princess, Jenna is whisked from her home and carried toward safety by the Extraordinary Wizard; those she always believed were her brother and father, and a young guard while being pursued by agents of those who killed her mother ten years earlier.
Book 1 in the Septimus Heap series.
- J STEWART Stewart, Paul. [The Edge Chronicles: Beyond the Deepwoods](#). 2004
Thirteen year old Twig, having always looked and felt different from his woodtroll family, learns he is adopted and begins a quest to find the place he belongs. On his journey, he meets a collection of odd companions; always watching out for the horrible gloamglozer, as he steadfastly pursues his quest of discovering who he is. Book 1 in the Edge Chronicles series.
- J URE Ure, Jean. [The Wizard in the Woods](#). 1990
Ben-Muzzy is a second grade junior wizard who miscasts a spell and finds himself transported from his magical world into this more earthly one. Twins Gemma and Joel discover him and try to help him home. There is plenty of adventure along the way.
- J VANDELVEL Vande Velde, Vivian. [Wizard at Work](#). 2003
A young wizard, who runs a school to teach wizards, looks forward to a quiet summer off but is drawn into adventures with princesses, unicorns, and ghosts instead.
- J WAGGONER Waggoner, Tim. [Temple of the Dragonslayer](#). 2004
In celebration of the 20th anniversary of the Dragonlance series, comes the first in a new series of adventures in the magical world of Krynn. The action begins with Nearra waking in a forest to find she has no memory of her life. She is rescued by a wizard and his guide and the journey begins to find out who she is. Book 1 in the Dragonlance: The New Adventures series.
- J YEP Yep, Laurence. [The Tiger's Apprentice](#). 2003
A tiger, a monkey, a dragon, and a twelve year old Chinese boy fight to keep a magic talisman out of the hands of an enemy who would use its power to destroy the world. Book 1 in the Tiger's Apprentice series.
- J YOLEN Yolen, Jane. [Wizard's Hall](#). 1991
The instant Henry casually mentions wizardry to his mother, she packs him off to Wizard's Hall, with little more than a change of clothes and the advice that whatever he encounters, it only matters that you try. And try Henry does though he has little magic talent. But quickly he learns that he has a mysterious extra burden of responsibility that no one will explain.

- J ABBOTT Abbott, Tony. [The Hidden Stairs and the Magic Carpet](#). 1999
Neal and Julie agree to help Eric clean his basement but never imagine that they're in for more than getting a little dusty. There the floor evaporates to reveal a rainbow staircase to another world and that's when the adventure begins. Book 1 in the Secrets of Droon series.
- J ALEXANDE Alexander, Lloyd. [The Rope Trick](#). 2002
Motivated by her quest to learn a legendry rope trick, the magician Princess Lidi and her troupe, embark on a journey through Renaissance Italy that intertwines adventure, love and mystery.
- J ARDAGH Ardagh, Philip. [A House Called Awful End: Book One of the Eddie Dickens Trilogy](#). 2002
When eleven year old Eddie Dickens' ill parents become "a bit crinkly round the edges," he is taken by his great-uncle and great-aunt and embarks on adventures that involve strolling actors, St. Horrid's Home for Grateful Orphans, and a carnival float like a giant cow. Book 1 in the Eddie Dickens Trilogy.
- J BAGGOTT Baggott, Julianna. [The Anybodies](#). 2004
Fern isn't a bit like her parents, the exceptionally ordinary Drudgers. That makes sense once she learns she's adopted and actually a changeling with a down-on-his-luck hypnotist father and a mother who died and left a book in code, The Art of Being Anybody, which her father and his archenemy are both after.
- J/YA BAILEY Bailey, Len. [Clabbernappers](#). 2005
Eleven year old Oklahoma rodeo champ Danny Ray is sent to the kingdom of Elidor, where he sets sail across the Checkered Sea to rescue a kidnapped queen, despite the enemies found there.
- J BELLAIRS Bellairs, John. [The Tower at the End of the World](#). 2001
In this sequel to The House with a Clock in It's Walls, Lewis and Rose Rita battle Ishmael Izard, the son of the evil magician who tried to destroy the world with the Doomsday Clock.
- J BYNG Byng, Georgia. [Molly Moon's Incredible Book of Hypnotism](#). 2002
When ten year old Molly Moon happens upon a rare copy of a how-to book on hypnotism, her drab orphanage life is over. No longer powerless and unwanted, she instead becomes an adored star in complete control of her Broadway audiences. The only problem is a hungry criminal after Molly and her book. Book 1 in the Molly Moon series

- J/YA COLFER Colfer, Eoin. [Artemis Fowl](#). 2001
When a twelve year old evil genius tries to restore his family fortune by capturing a fairy and demanding a ransom in gold, the fairies fight back with magic, technology, and a particularly nasty troll. Book 1 in the Artemis Fowl series.
- J COVILLE Coville, Bruce. [The Dragon of Doom](#). 2003
Life in the village is boring until an aspiring magician and his toad come to town and ask Edward to help them slay the Dragon of Doom. Book 1 in the Moongobble and Me series.
- J COVILLE Coville, Bruce. [Jeremy Thatcher, Dragon Hatcher](#). 1991
Small for his age but artistically inspired, twelve year old Jeremy Thatcher unknowingly buys a dragon's egg and that's when the adventure begins. Book 1 in the Magic Shop Book series.
- J CRILLEY Crilley, Mark. [Billy Klikk: Creach Battler](#). 2004.
Twelve-year-old Billy discovers that his parents' extermination business is really a cover for something a whole lot more sinister. The fantastical world here isn't a world of magicians or fairies; it's a world of skark-weevils, narfms and orfs. As much science fiction as it is fantasy, Billy's story will appeal to readers in search of adventure, humor and a hero with a mission.
- J DALE Dale, Anna. [Whispering to Witches](#). 2004
On his way to spend Christmas at his mother's house in Canterbury, England, Joe meets a young witch named Twiggly and becomes part of a mystery involving a missing page from an ancient book of magic.
- J DOWNER Downer, Ann. [Hatching Magic](#). 2003
When a thirteenth century wizard confronts twenty-first century Boston while seeking his pet dragon, he is followed by a rival wizard and a very unhappy demon, but eleven-year-old Theodora may hold the secret to setting everything right.
- J DOYLE Doyle, Debra. [School of Wizardry](#). 1990
Determined to become a wizard, twelve-year-old Randall is delighted to be accepted into the famed School of Wizardry, but his apprenticeship is marred when he realizes that one of the master wizards is using evil spells to destroy the school and gain supreme power. Book 1 in the Circle of Magic series.
- J/YA FUNKE Funke, Cornelia. [Inkheart](#). 2003

- J GLIORI Gliori, Debi. [Pure Dead Magic](#). 2001
When their father is kidnapped and danger looms, the Strega-Borgia children, their new nanny, and a giant tarantula use magic and actual trips through the Internet to bring peace to their Scottish castle. Book 1 in the Pure Dead series.
- J IBBOTSON Ibbotson, Eva. [The Secret of Platform 13](#). 1994
Ode Gribble, a young hag, accompanies an old wizard, a gentile fey, and a giant ogre on their mission through a magical tunnel from their Island to London to rescue their King and Queen's son, who had been stolen as an infant.
- J/YA LEGUIN Le Guin, Ursula. [A Wizard of Earthsea](#). 1968
A boy grows to manhood while attempting to subdue the evil he unleashed on the world as an apprentice to the Master Wizard. Book 1 in the Earthsea Trilogy.
